
Village of Winneconne Description for Street Vacation - South Fourth St.

A part of the Plat of Williamsport, Village of Winneconne, Winnebago County, Wisconsin, described as: Beginning at the intersection of the East Line of South Fourth Street with the South Line of Lincoln Street; thence South along the East Line of South Fourth Street, also being the West Line of Block 18, Plat of Williamsport, 233 feet more or less to the South Line of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of said Section 21; Township 19 North, Range 15 East; thence West along the South Line of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of said Section 21, 66 feet to the West Line of South Fourth Street; thence North along the West Line of South Fourth Street; thence North along the West Line of Lincoln Street; thence East 66 feet to the point of beginning.

NOTICE TO VACATE & PORTION OF SOUTH FOURTE STREET FROM THE INTERSECTION OF LINCOLN STREET TO THE MORTH BANK OF THE CANAL, VILLAGE OF WINEBCORNE, WISCOMSIN.

1. -- A. ...

WHEREAS, the Village Board of the Village of Winnecome has reason to be concerned, and has deliberated as to vecating that portion of South Yourth Street from the intersection of Lincoln Strest to the North bank of the cenul, in the Village, and hereinafter described, and that vecating of sold street as identified would be in the public's interest, and requires a public hearing to inform the public of a determination to be made by the Village Board.

RESOLVEL, that a public hearing on the passage of a resolution be held by the Village Board on the 20th day of June, 1974, at 7:30 o'clock P.M. in the Village Hell, Village of Winddonne.

That notice of such bearing be given by publication in the official Villege paper. Minnecome News.

That sotion of auch hearing shall be given and served on the owners of all frontage of lots and lands abutting upon that portion sought to be vecated and discustizzed.

A description of the premises sought to be vacated is described as follows:

> Beginning at the southeast curner of Edock 16, Plat of Williamsport, thence west 66 fluer thence south 66 ft.; thence northeast to forming a tri-angular piece of land to the point of beginning.

A part of the Plat of Williamsport, Village of Winneconne, Winnebago County, Wisconsin, described as: Beginning at the intersection of the East Line of South Fourth Street with the South Line of Lincoln Street; thence South along the Sest Line of South Fourth Street, also being the West Line of Block 18, Plat of Williamsport, 233 feet more or less to the South Line of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of said Section 21, Township 19 Morth, Range 15 East; thence West along the South Line of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of said Section

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21, 66 feat to the West Line of South Fourth Street; thence North along the West Line of South Fourth Street, 233 feat more or less to the South Line of Lincoln Street; thence East 66 feat to the point of beginning.

That the map showing the portion of South Fourth Street sought to be vacated is attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

That this Village Clerk cause a copy of this resolution, with map attached, to be served upon the property owners pursuant to Section 66,296 (2) a. and b. and (5), and cause a like copy to be filed in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Winnebago County, Wieconsin, pursuant to Section 281.04 of the Wisconsin Statutes, in which case made and provided for.
