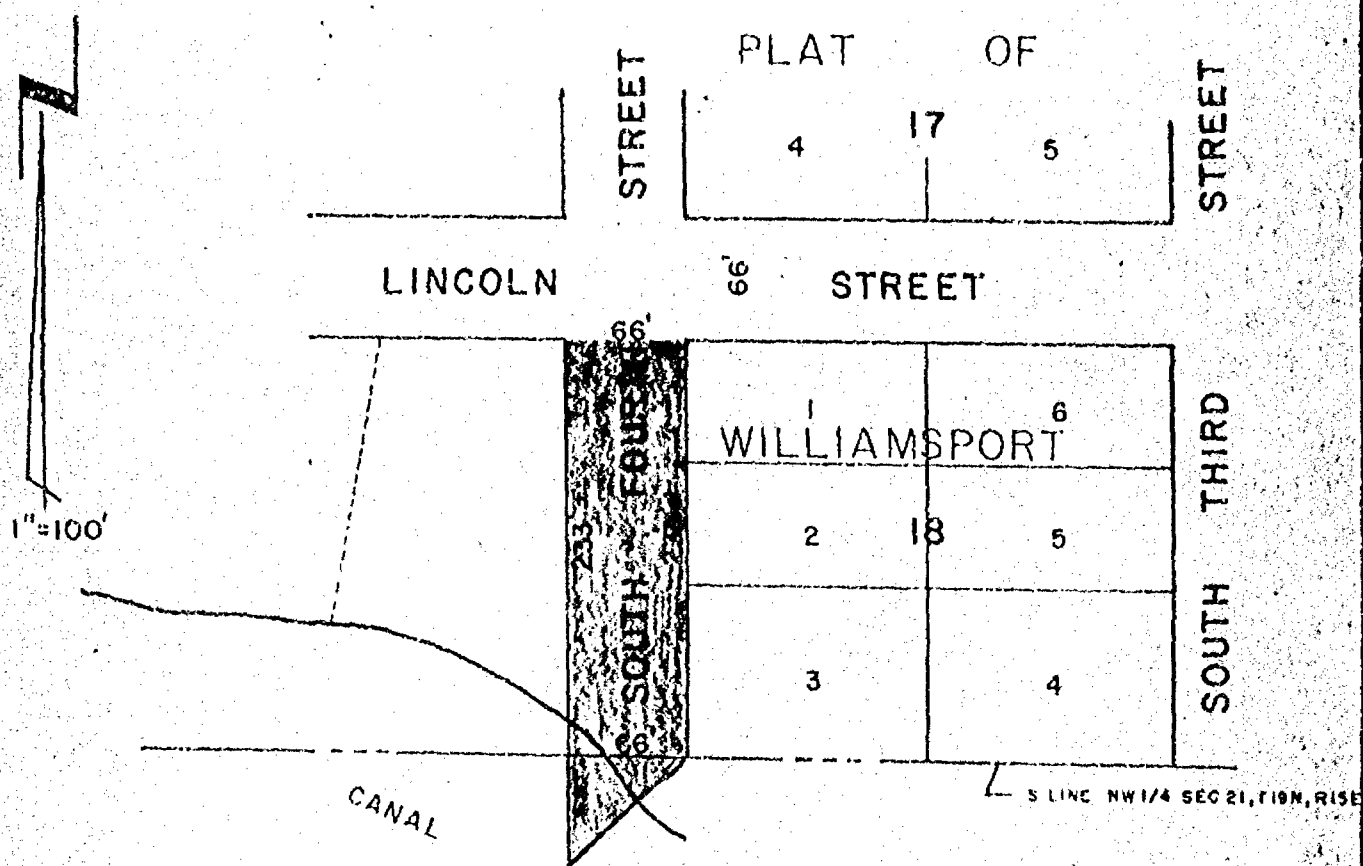


Village of Winneconne Description

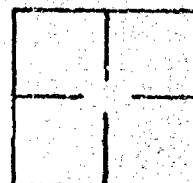
A part of the Plat of Williamsport, Village of Winneconne, Winnebago County, Wisconsin, described as: Beginning at the intersection of the East Line of South Fourth Street with the South Line of Lincoln Street; thence South along the East Line of South Fourth Street, also being the West Line of Block 18, Plat of Williamsport, 233 feet more or less to the South Line of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of said Section 21, Township 19 North, Range 15 East; thence West along the South Line of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of said Section 21, 66 feet to the West Line of South Fourth Street; thence North along the West Line of South Fourth Street, 233 feet more or less to the South Line of Lincoln Street; thence East 66 feet to the point of beginning.

RESOLUTION

NOTICE TO VACATE A PORTION OF SOUTH FOURTH STREET FROM THE INTERSECTION OF LINCOLN STREET TO THE NORTH BANK OF THE CANAL, VILLAGE OF WINNECONNE, WISCONSIN.

WHEREAS, the Village Board of the Village of Winneconne has reason to be concerned, and has deliberated as to vacating that portion of South Fourth Street from the intersection of Lincoln Street to the North bank of the canal, in the Village, and hereinafter described, and that vacating of said street as identified would be in the public's interest, and requires a public hearing to inform the public of a determination to be made by the Village Board.

RESOLVED, that a public hearing on the passage of a resolution be held by the Village Board on the 20th day of June, 1974, at 7:30 o'clock P.M. in the Village Hall, Village of Winneconne.

That notice of such hearing be given by publication in the official Village paper, Winneconne News.

That notice of such hearing shall be given and served on the owners of all frontage of lots and lands abutting upon that portion sought to be vacated and discontinued.

A description of the premises sought to be vacated is described as follows:

Beginning at the southeast corner of Block 18, Plat of Williamsport, thence west 66 ft.; thence south 66 ft.; thence northeast to forming a triangular piece of land to the point of beginning.

A part of the Plat of Williamsport, Village of Winneconne, Winnebago County, Wisconsin, described as: Beginning at the intersection of the East Line of South Fourth Street with the South Line of Lincoln Street; thence South along the East Line of South Fourth Street, also being the West Line of Block 18, Plat of Williamsport, 233 feet more or less to the South Line of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of said Section 21, Township 19 North, Range 15 East; thence West along the South Line of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of said Section

21, 66 feet to the West Line of South Fourth Street; thence North along the West Line of South Fourth Street, 233 feet more or less to the South Line of Lincoln Street; thence East 66 feet to the point of beginning.

That the map showing the portion of South Fourth Street sought to be vacated is attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

That the Village Clerk cause a copy of this resolution, with map attached, to be served upon the property owners pursuant to Section 66.296 (2) a. and b. and (5), and cause a like copy to be filed in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Winnebago County, Wisconsin, pursuant to Section 281.04 of the Wisconsin Statutes, in which case made and provided for.
