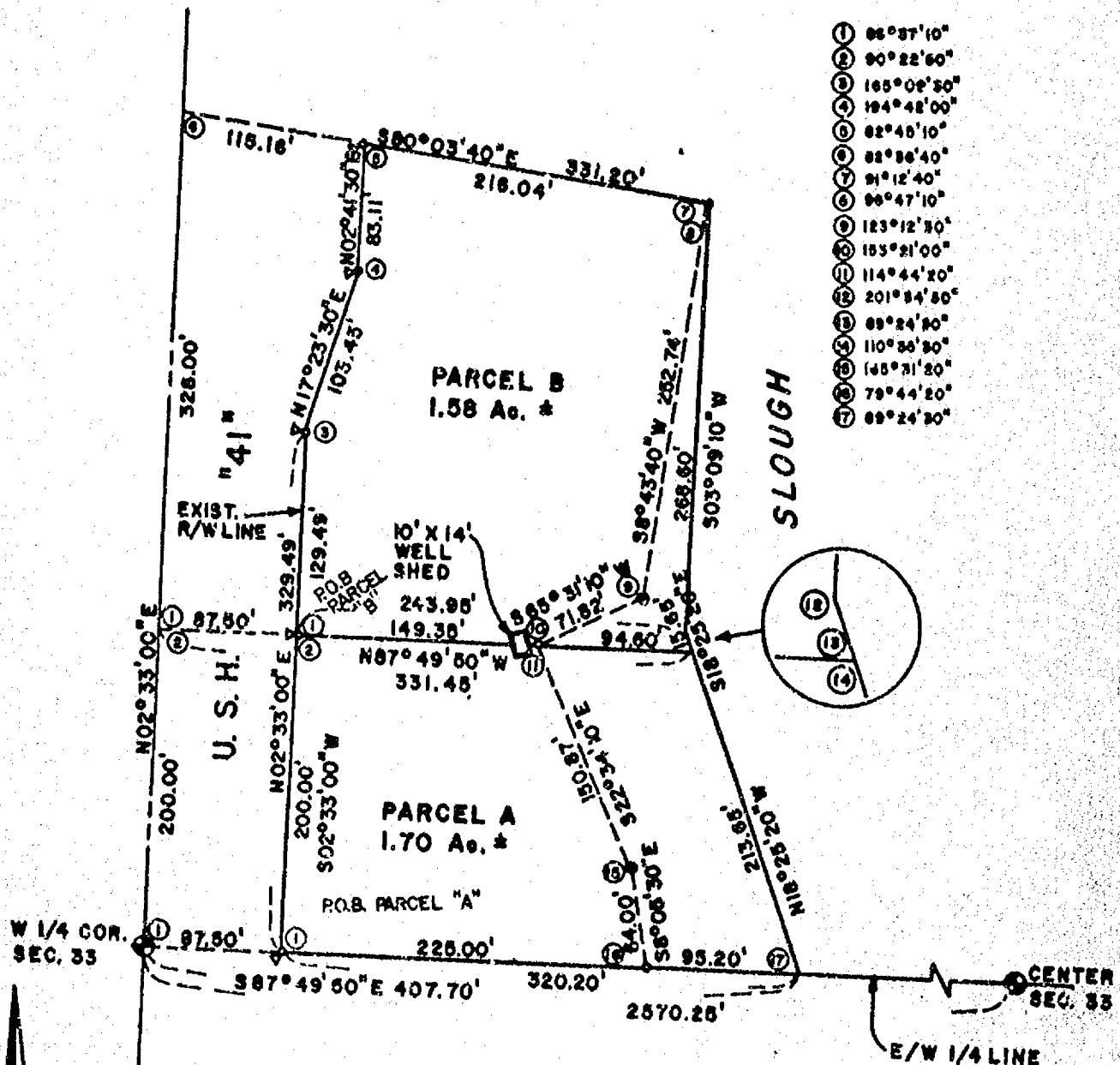


Plat of Survey

CITY OF NEENAH, WINNEBAGO CO., WI



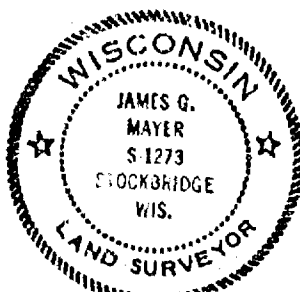
