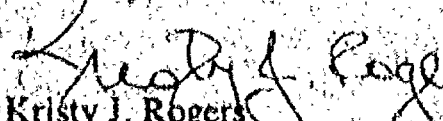
Dear Mr. Nerenhausen:

SUBJECT: Navigability Determination / Confirmation - *MATHWIG*

Dear Mr. Braun:

I am writing in regard to your request for a navigability determination of an unnamed pond and connected waterway located in the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 8, T17N, R16E, Town of Nekemi, Winnebago County.

As you are aware, Tere Locke (former area water management specialist, WDNR) determined that the pond in the above named location was and is in fact Navigable. This pond has a defined bed and banks and is capable of floating a shallow draft recreational watercraft on a regular recurring basis. Further research into this matter showed that the original U.S. Government Survey Maps of 1833 and 1834 illustrated that the above pond has a natural waterbody history. Although the pond and surrounding wetlands have been heavily altered, this pond shall still be considered Navigable.

On October 20, 1998, Mike Russo, Keith Patrick, and myself inspected the above-mentioned location to review a culvert permit application for George Mathwig (Doc# 3-NE-98-044UI). The permit application was ultimately dismissed because the watercourse which flows North from the pond was determined to be Non-Navigable. This non-navigability determination was made because this section of watercourse does not have defined bed or banks. Although a point of Navigability was not established downstream, the watercourse shall be considered Non-Navigable for a minimum distance of 1000 feet North of the pond.
