Dear Ms. Hessefort:

This letter is in response to your request for a navigability determination of Honey Creek located in the Town of Algoma, SW 1/4, NW 1/4, section 16, T18N, R16E, Winnebago County.

Honey Creek is navigable here as there are defined banks, and a bed and sufficient water to float a small watercraft on an annual recurring basis.

The Department does not have any record of springs in this area. However, if you want to see if springs are seeping into the creek, you can take water temperatures along the shoreline at various intervals. If the temperature decreases in some areas, spring may be seeping into the creek.

I do not know what impacts the construction of a road would have on the surrounding area in conjunction with the springs.
