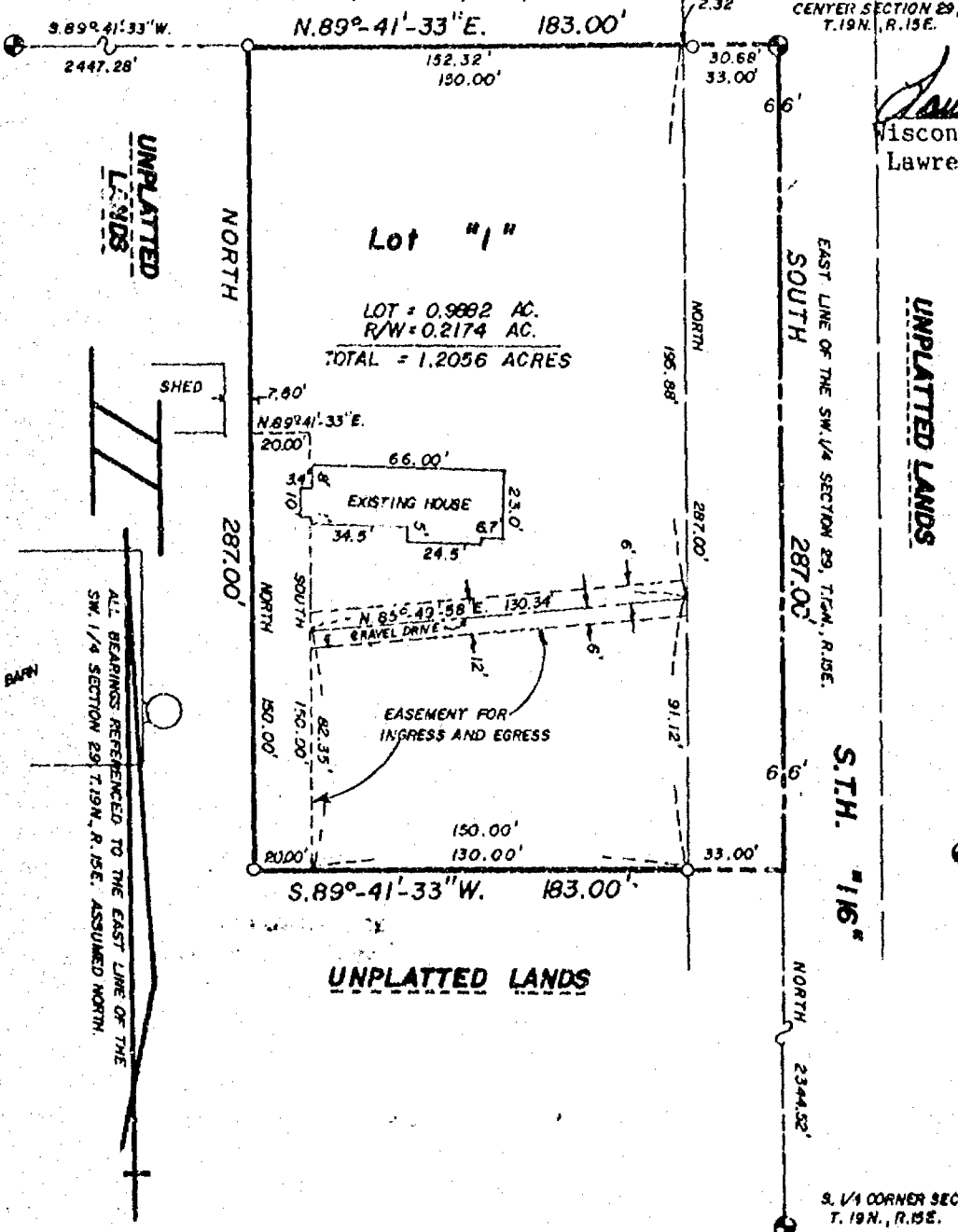

T. 19N., R. 15E.



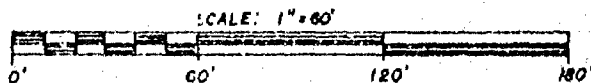
