Dear Mr. Powelett:

This letter is in response to plans you sent regarding the proposed detention pond located in the Town of Oshkosh, NW 1/4, NW 1/4, section 35, T19N, R16E, Winnebago County.

On June 19, 1992 I investigated the area and found the creek to be navigable as there are defined banks and a bed and there is sufficient water to float a small water craft on an annual recurring basis.

The plans which you sent, do not show where the creek is in relationship to the proposed pond. As we discussed over the telephone a Chapter 30 permit is required if the pond will be located within 500 feet of that creek or if the pond will be connected to that creek.

Attached is an application for a permit.
