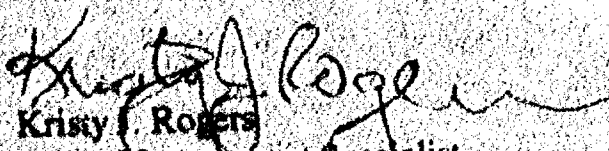
Dear Mr. Ise:

This letter follows up your request for a navigability determination for a waterway located in Sections 25 and 30, Township 20 North, Range 16 East, Town of Clayton, Winnebago County.

A field investigation on June 12, 1995 resulted in a determination that this waterway was not navigable. A second field investigation was completed this week to confirm that determination. The waterway does not have a defined bed and bank and is not capable of floating a small watercraft.

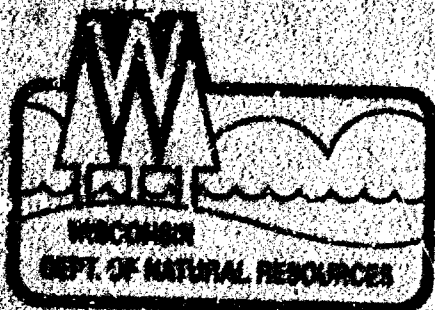
